FIRST IMPRESSION

GRADY-WHITE 321 COASTAL EXPLORER

The 321 Coastal Explorer mixes inshore and offshore fishing capabilities with luxury and top engineering and construction. It is the largest Grady-White Coastal Explorer model.

Riding Grady's exclusive SeaV² hull, the 321 CE is built for anglers and families who expect more from their time on the water. Integrated aft boarding platforms ensure easy water access in case you add aftermarket dual shallow-water anchors. At the bow, meticulous tolerance checks allow the largest available trolling motors to stow and deploy without interfering with the anchor locker or forward seating.

The black helm offers push-buttons, an upholstered brow, and space for dual 19-inch displays. Ride in comfort in triple Command Elite helm chairs that include flip-up bolsters,



fold-down armrests, and footrests. Powered by dual Yamaha F350s with Helm Master EX, the 321 CE comes standard with the Siren Marine Connected Boat Monitoring System. Yamaha's new wireless controller is an option.

We were impressed during a boat show walkthrough, noting features such as twin fold-out cockpit terraces. A sea-trial is to come.

Powered by twin Yamaha F350 outboards, the Grady-White 321 Coastal Explorer is said to hit a 56-mph top speed.
