Grady-White's new **EXPRESS 340** exceeds the dreams and desires of boaters.

The new year always starts off with the promise of change for the better. Grady-White's innovative upgrades has delivered on that promise with the new Express 340. Its bold yet elegant redesigns have added an abundance of modern, luxurious features that will definitely upgrade your boating experience, while also satisfying your needs from a high-performance vessel.

"When the Express 330 was introduced in 2001, it was the first outboard sportfishing cabin boat of its kind," notes Christian Carraway, Grady-White Senior Product Designer. "Through the years it has continued to be a winner with its classic design, amazing ride compliments of the SeaV2® hull, and Grady-White's continuous improvement philosophy. In this remodel, the new 340 preserves our sportfishing heritage but with an added level of luxury and comfort our customers will not find in

any other boats in this class." Performance is driven by the legendary SeaV2® hull, delivering one of the smoothest rides on the water, while certified unsinkable foam flotation and a true self-bailing cockpit provide confidence offshore.

The spacious, elevated helm features push button switches and room for dual 19-inch displays, as well as a Yamaha Helm Master® EX with Full Maneuverability. Portside from the contoured captain's chair you can be seated at the wraparound companion bench. Upgrades in space were definitely top of mind with this design, with expanded cabinetry and more creative uses of space taking hold — not to mention plenty of seating including aft-facing, under-hardtop mezzanine seating with pullout footrest that transitions for entertaining or as a work space when folding down the backrest to reveal a Dekton sintered stone counter with hideaway storage. All this with a variety of natural light sources from the oversized hatch and sky light, giving you ample ways to enjoy trips out on the water.

The 340 is equipped with an AV2® hardtop enclosure featuring an integrated hatch, four horizontal hanging rod holders, four side-mounted rod holders, Clear2Sea™ side and drop curtains, and a SureShade® system for adaptable protection in changing conditions. A well-appointed rigging station offers a Dekton® sintered stone counter, sink, and ample storage, with optional upgrades for a grill and



refrigerator to support extended days on the water. Anglers will appreciate the thoughtful fish-handling setup, which includes a 166-quart insulated fish box with optional freezer/refrigerator with digital thermostat, a 32-gallon livewell, and an 87-quart insulated box with a recessed faucet for easy cleanup.

Throughout the cockpit and cabin, elegant indirect lighting enhances both ambiance and functionality. Below deck, the air-conditioned cabin features a center-entry sliding door and floating stairs leading to a comfortable layout with a vee berth and table, aft berth, TV, microwave, stove, refrigerator, sink, and abundant storage for extended cruising.

The captain and crew will find ease in entertaining no matter where on the boat everyone congregates. USB ports are located in all seating areas, as well as a wireless phone charger at the helm. Everything that can and should be held is catered to, from rod holders above that are strategically placed out of the way but easily accessible, to stainless steel overboard draining drink holders throughout the boat. More features include a cockpit pullout shower with a hot/cold mixer, Phender Pro™ quick-release fender cleats, remote engine flush system, and an anchor windlass with remote switches.

Attention to detail is a signature of Grady-White boats, and the 340 is no

exception. Luxury touches were expertly built into the redesigned cabin, now even more expansive. The increased width and headroom now sleeps four across two large berths, with custom lounge backrests that are integrated into the bolsters. This elevated experience also flows into the enclosed head which is equally refined, offering a sink, stand-up shower with dedicated wand, fold-down oak shower seat, Vacu-Flush® head, vanity mirror with storage, and a skylight that fills the space with natural light.
